
Five Weeks of Memory Verses and Songs to Teach the Christmas Story

- A simple five week advent program for kids
- Includes the week of Epiphany (Three Kings Day)
- Includes a simple memory verse each week
- Includes songs for each week to sing or listen to
- Includes overall idea and memory verse for entire season
- Includes printable of memory verses (page 3)

Additional Suggestions:

- ~ Expand the story each week by reading the story from the Bible and/or reading a book about the story of Christmas.
- ~ Use a nativity scene to illustrate the story as you tell it. If possible use a kid friendly version made of wood or plastic so the kids can help tell the story.
- ~ Find printable nativity figures to print out, cut out, and attach to popsicle sticks to use when telling the story.
- ~ Add a craft or coloring page for the kids to do.
- ~ Review the names of Jesus covered in the verses: Emmanuel, Messiah, Christ, Lord, Savior, and the Word. Also, Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Make names of Jesus ornaments. https://biblestoryprintables.com/?s=names+of+jesus
- ~ The Wise Men followed the star. Make a star craft or star cookies.
- ~ January 6th is Three Kings Day, and the twelfth day after Christmas
- ~ The word epiphany means "manifestation" or "revelation."
- ~ Worship through prayer and singing.
